Notice of a Community Governance Review

Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007

Local Government (Parish and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008

The Council has commenced a Community Governance Review in response to a request from Kennett Parish Council to increase the number of councillors from five to seven. The purpose of the review is to enable the Council to consider what changes are needed to the parish arrangements.

At the Full Council meeting on 25 May 2010 the following draft proposal was approved;

‘ That the number of parish councillors on Kennett Parish council be increased from 5 to 7, to come into effect for the parish elections in May 2011.’

The council is now conducting the second stage of the review process and is inviting residents and interested organisations to submit their views on the above issues.

The Council has published its Terms of Reference Document for the review and a copy can be obtained by contacting the Electoral Services team as shown below or viewed at the Council’s Offices.
