2. **Matters arising from the Minutes**

Bridge Weight Limit The clerk is to write to Suffolk Highways to get an update on the Herringswell Road bridge.

Memorial stones Ivett & Reed have scheduled the work, there is no news yet.

Dog Loos The 2 new dog-foul bins are in place.

Street Lighting Streetlight PC16 in Station Road is faulty, the clerk to report it.

Graveyard Hedge The clerk confirmed the order with S P Landscapes.

Neighbourhood Panels Barclay Dutson attended the 2nd July meeting, he reported that: The anti-social behaviour measures had been effective. Speedwatch has been a success, Health and Safety restricts them to 30mph areas only. There are concerns about the speed limit outside the school. They are trying to reactivate the Neighbourhood Watch system. The next meeting is to be on the 8th October.

3. **Parish Councillor Co-option** The Parish Council agreed to co-opt Darren Watson at a special meeting on the 7th July. The clerk confirmed the appointment and provided him with a copy of The Code of Conduct. The Declaration of Interests is to be completed.
